**PURPOSE:** Implement good practice, safeguarding and child protection policies

**COMMITMENT:** 8 -12 meetings a year plus ad hoc admin tasks.

## **Roles and Responsibilities**

- 1. Act as the first point of contact for individuals who have queries or concerns regarding safeguarding.
- 2. Ensure that all club personnel who work with children have received appropriate training.
- 3. Facilitate the process of DBS checks when required.
- 4. Receive, record and forward to the Lead Officer of your Home Nation any concerns that are expressed to you.
- 5. Keep confidential records of all related documents.
- 6. Ensure that the club has a safeguarding and child protection policy and that this is followed and accessible to all.
- 7. Be familiar with national safeguarding and child protection policies

## **Required Candidate Skills and Qualities**

- 8. Essential to attend a sports coach UK Safeguarding and Protecting Children workshop England, Scotland, Wales.
- 9. Desirable to attend the Child Protection in Sport Unit, Time to Listen workshop delivered via the county sports partnerships network.
- 10. Approachable and a good listener.
- 11. Respect of confidentiality.
- 12. Tactful and discrete.
- 13. Knowledge of Child Protection policies and DBS checks.
- 14. Basic knowledge of the roles and responsibilities of local statutory agencies and their contact details.
- 15. Ability to manage issues if / when they occur.
